

## **CHARTER FOR THE ROYAL GROUNDS KEEPERS**

**I. The RGK shall exist to oversee development and management of the Emerald Hills leased real estate (Tanglewood Forest) in Purdon, Texas.**

**II. The RGK shall consist of seven (7) dues paid members of the Emerald Hills of Amtgard.**

**1. There are four(4) automatic seats in the RGK:**

**a) David Hall (Sir McFadden)**

**b) Liaison/ Groundskeeper (person holding this position shall agree to a quarterly performance evaluation by the RGK and will abide by the decision of the RGK to improve their performance and/or be replaced by vote of the RGK.**

**c) The current Monarch of the Emerald Hills or a person appointed by the monarch and approved by the RGK.**

**d) an RGK appointee from the Emerald Hills BOD (in any term if the BOD so chooses, their seat may be assigned by the RGK).**

**Any RGK member may be voted out of their position as per Emerald Hills Corpora.**

**2. The remaining three(3) seats shall be voted on annually during the Emerald Hills Kingdom level Mid Reign. The annual terms shall be staggered so that there is always a member that was active during the preceding 6 months).**

**III. The RGK shall maintain a bank account and manage its own RGK funds .**

**IV. The RGK funds are generated from the following sources:**

**1. 50% of the gate fees from Emerald Hills events held at Tanglewood Forest**

**2. Tanglewood Forest shall be leased for Non Emerald Hills events on a case by case basis.**

**3. Private Donations**

**4. Donations from the Emerald Hills Kingdom.**

**V. The RGK must adhere to the following provisions without exception before the Kingdom of the Emerald Hills can donate any funds to the RGK.**

**1. Form must be completed and submitted to the Kingdom Prime Minister.**

**2. Request must be approved by the Kingdom in a populace vote .**

**3. The RGK must provide an itemized Reconciliation Form, including receipts of the money donated from the Treasury of the Kingdom of the Emerald Hills.**

**VI. The RGK shall spend all monies generated from gate fees and private donations on the development and maintenance of Tanglewood Forest.**
